

## Note to Students and Parents of Students

**Kids' Classes:** I'm looking forward to working your children. We have a lot of fun and interesting art projects planned! Smocks are strongly encouraged. We get very messy and some of the materials stain clothing!

- I will be meeting you at the back entrance of 54 Main St. (with the green awning) 5 minutes before class starts and I will also bring students downstairs promptly at the end of class.
- Students may bring water bottles to the studio but please encourage your child to finish snacks prior to entering the studio.
- All students are entitled to feel safe and comfortable in the studio. Students are expected to be respectful and considerate of their classmates and instructors. In the event that a student is unable to meet this expectation, his or her parents will be called and instructed to pick up their child.
- Due to space constraints we cannot accommodate having siblings and parents accompany students to class. I would be happy to discuss other accommodations to ensure a successful art experience for your child.

**Adult and teen students who will be driving themselves to class:** Parking is available in the lot behind the building on River Street. Please use the adjacent entrance with the green awning. The studio is located on the 2nd Floor, #201.

Please make every effort to be on time. Late arrivals are extremely disruptive to the class. Many times demonstrations are interrupted and late students do not have sufficient time to “warm-up.” The warm-up is very important to the creative process and serves as an important transition for students who may be rushing from school, work or other activities to the studio. But I also realize that “stuff happens” and getting to the studio late may be unavoidable on occasion. My number is 978-430-9307.
